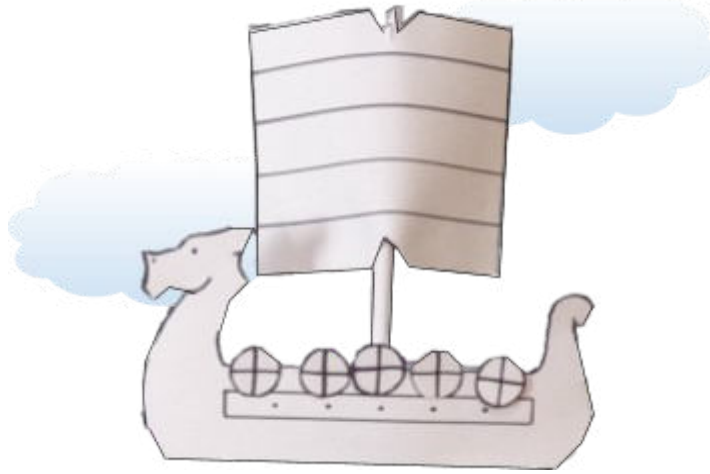
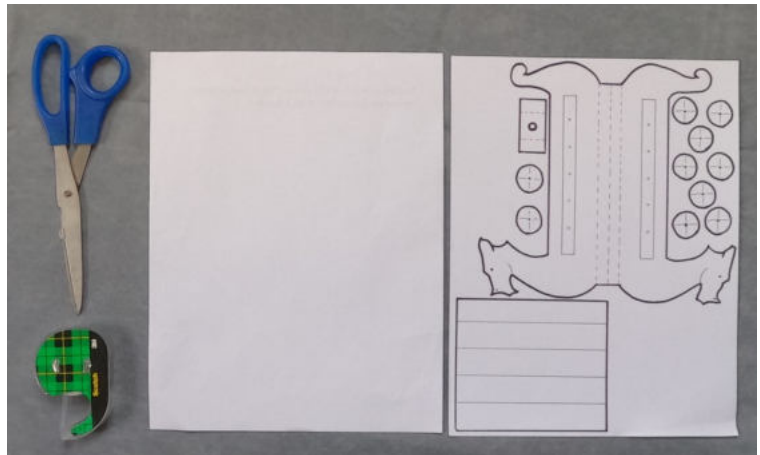


Model Viking Ship: Drakkar how to

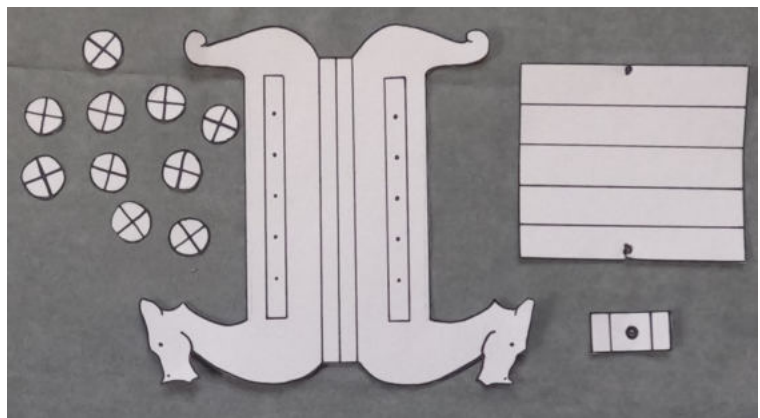
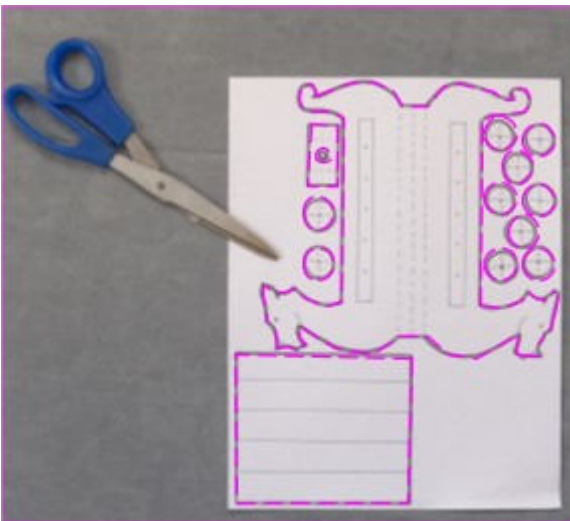


For this activity you will need:

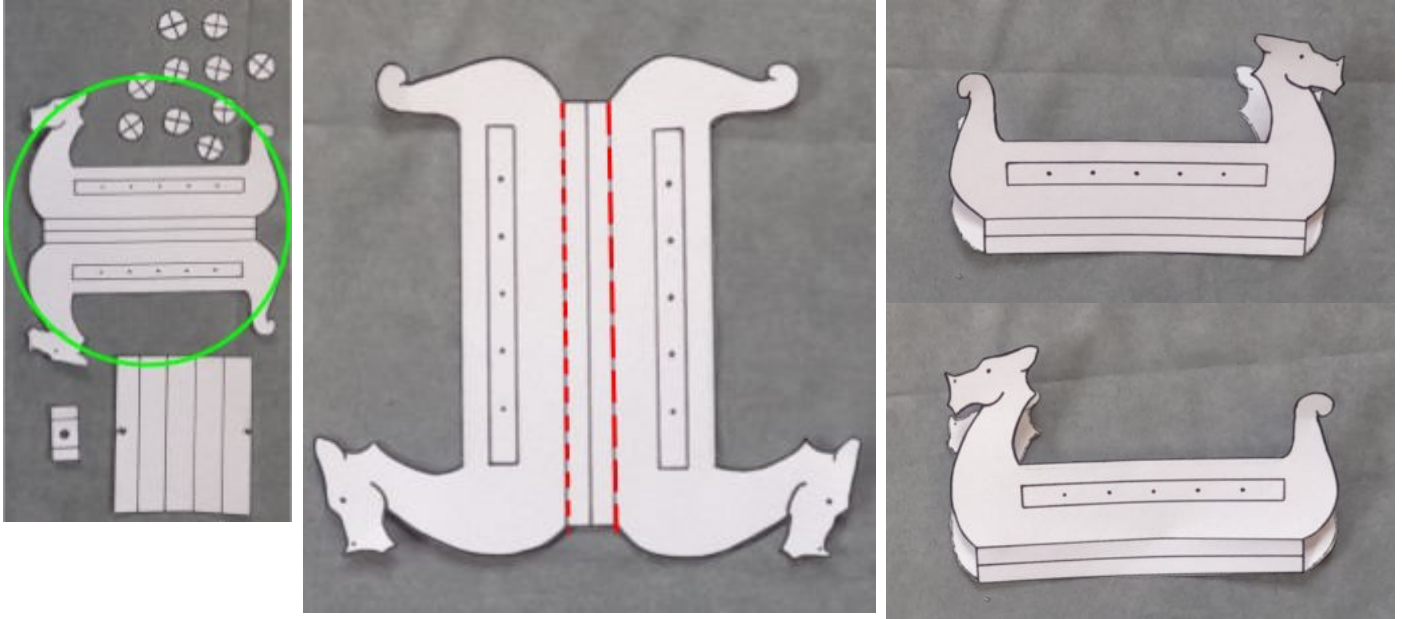
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 printed drakkar sheet
- 1 straw or 1 piece of paper
- Tape and/or glue



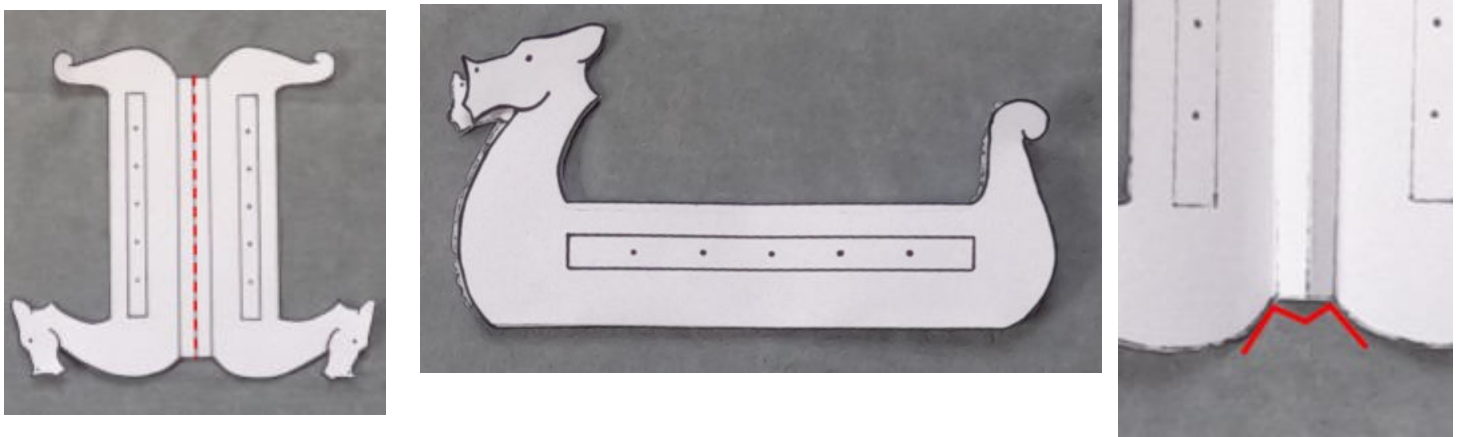
1. Cut along the dotted pink lines using scissors. You may want to ask for a parent's or older sibling's help.



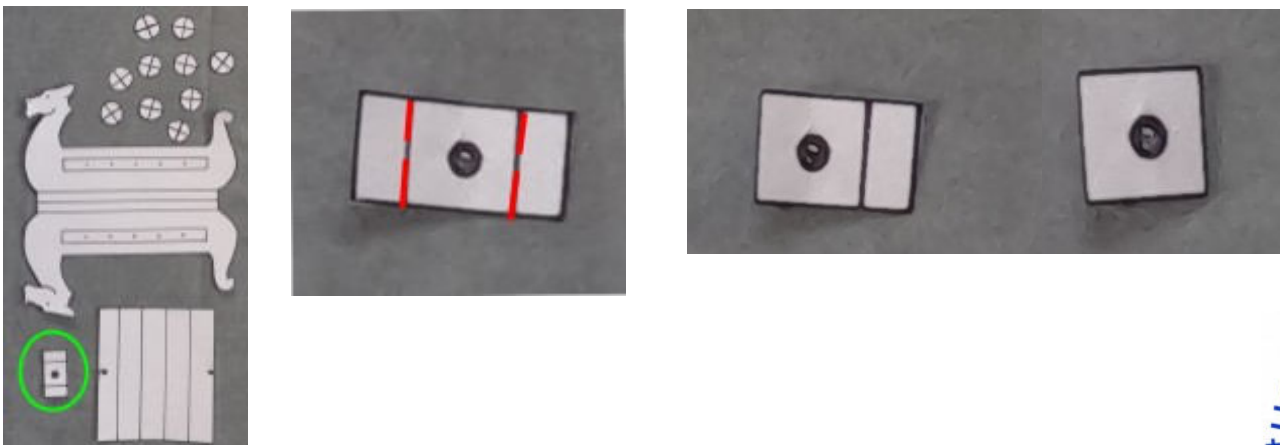
2. Take your drakkar's hull and fold along the dotted red lines.



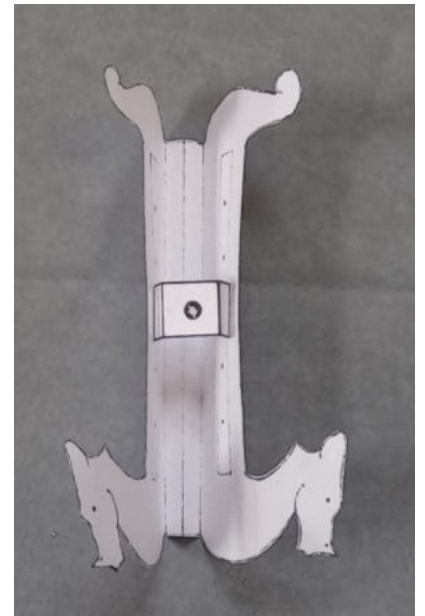
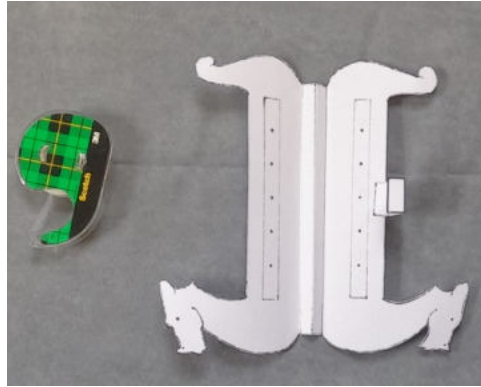
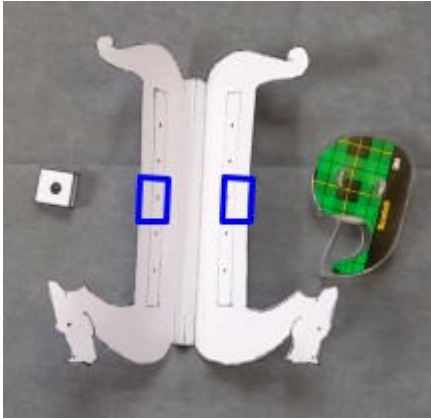
3. Fold the dotted red line up. Your Drakkar's bottom should have a "W" shape. (Note: it is helpful to pinch along the two previous folds).



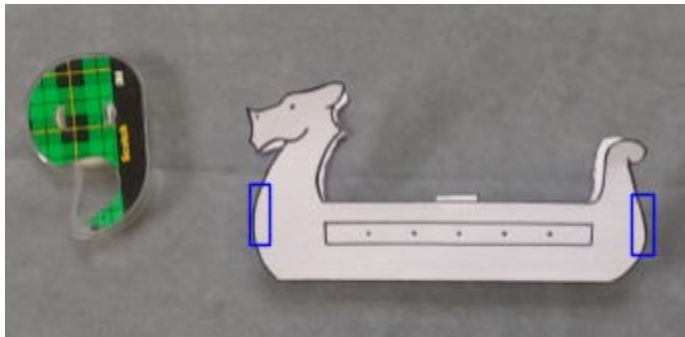
4. Take the rectangular cut-out and fold along the dotted red lines.



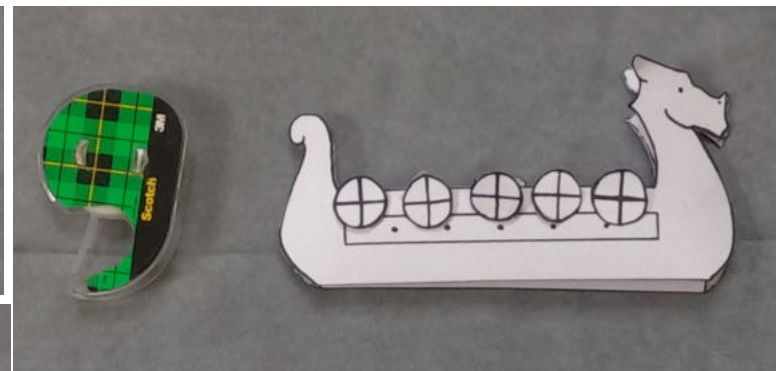
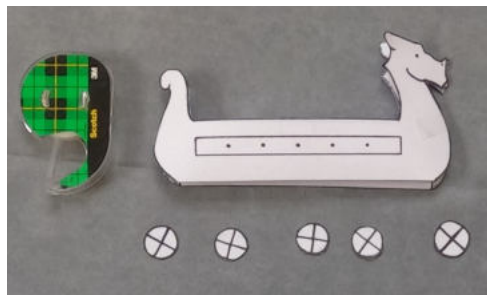
5. Tape/glue the folded edges of the rectangular cut-out in the center of the drakkar hull (apply glue/tape where the blue boxes are).



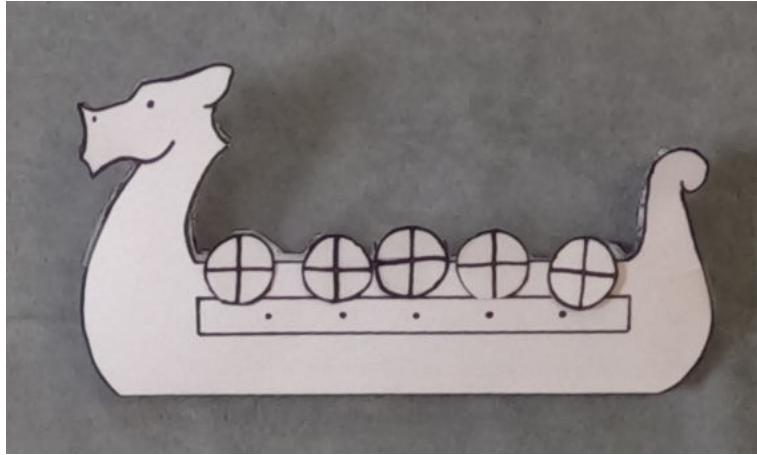
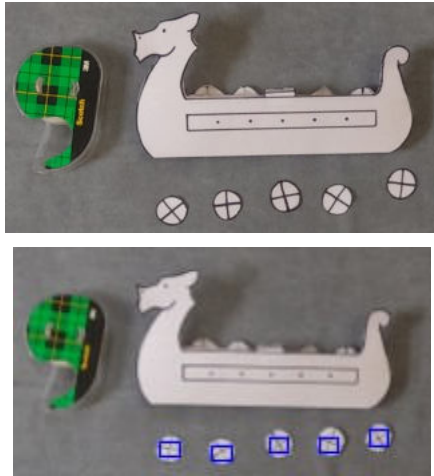
6. Tape/glue the bow and the stern together (apply glue/tape where the blue boxes are).



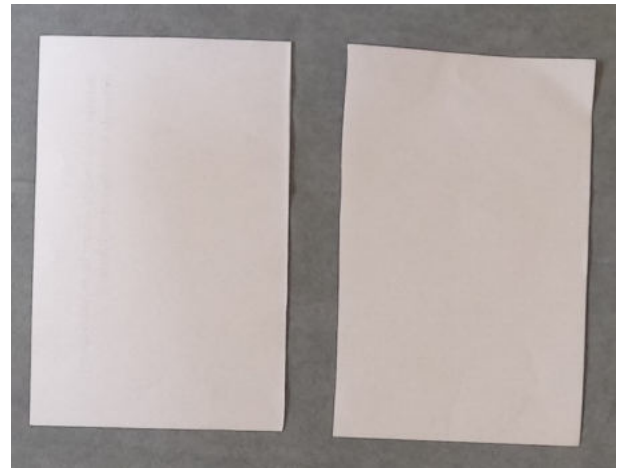
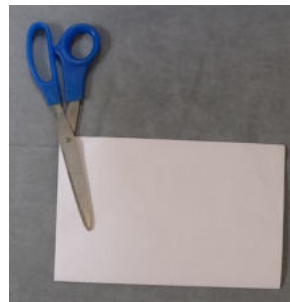
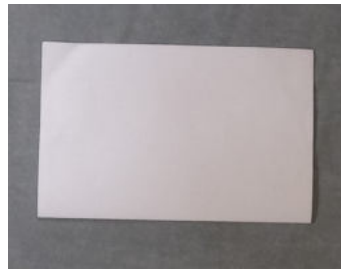
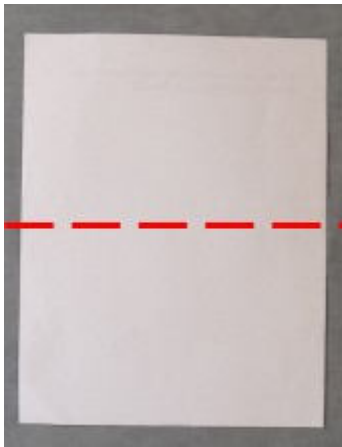
7. Tape/glue 5 cut-out shields (circles) to the drakkar's hull along the straight edge (apply glue/tape where the blue boxes are).



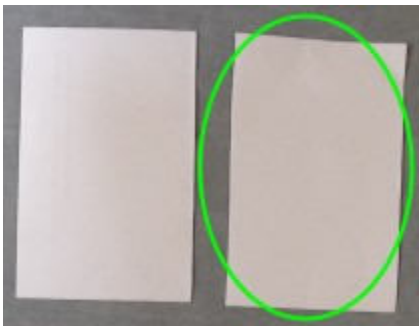
8. Repeat step 7 on the other side with the remaining 5 shields (apply glue/tape where the blue boxes are).



9. **[If you have a straw you can skip this step]** Grab your piece of scrap paper. Fold the paper in half along the dotted red line. Then cut the paper in half using this fold mark as a guide.



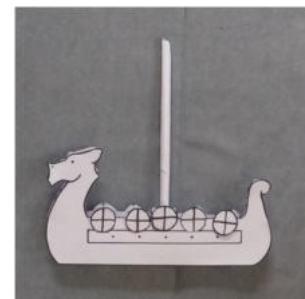
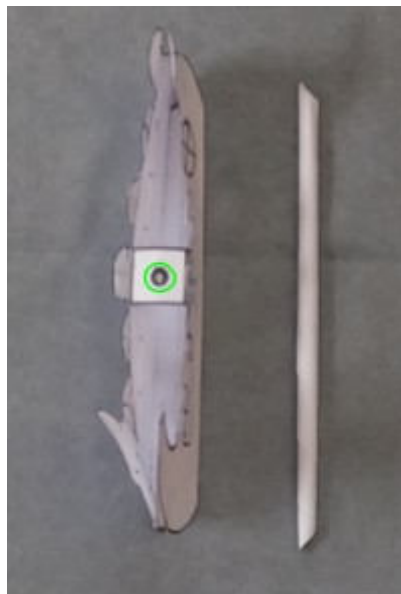
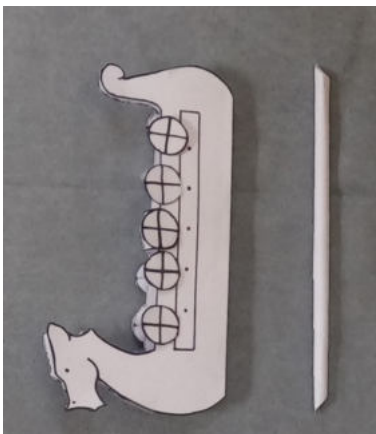
10. **[If you have a straw you can skip this step]** Grab one of the halves of the paper. Roll this paper into a cylinder starting from one corner.



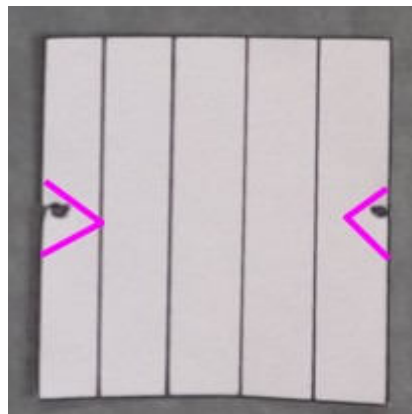
11. **[If you have a straw you can skip this step]** Tape/glue the end of the paper roll so it will not come undone (apply glue/tape where the blue boxes are).



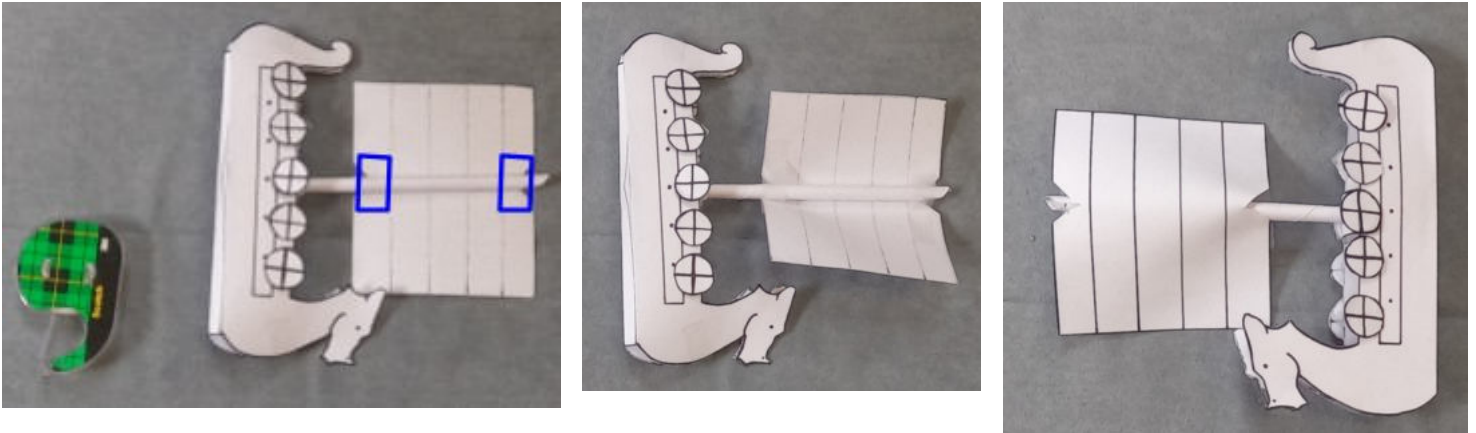
12. Insert your straw/paper roll into the hole in the rectangular cut-out. You have now created a mast.



13. Grab your square sail. Cut along the pink lines so that there are two small triangular pieces missing from either end of the sail.



14. Tape/glue your sail to the mast (apply glue/tape where the blue boxes are).



15. You are all done!
