

# The Snipe Class International Racing Association

Address all communications to W. F. Crosby, Executive Secretary, 9 Murray Street, New York, New York, U. S. A.

All boats should be registered with the Executive Secretary and have racing numbers assigned. If there is a fleet near, newly registered boat owners will be given the Fleet Captain's name and address. If no fleet exists, but if there are a number of other registered boats nearby, the owners will be put in touch in order to form a fleet. There is no charge for registration, but owners of such boats cannot become members of the Association until after their boats have been measured and dues of \$1.00 a year paid to the Association. Only registered, measured and paid-up boats are eligible to race. Owners of non-measured boats cannot pay dues or join Association. Upon receipt of dues, the Executive Secretary sends each owner a copy of the class rules and a membership card. Owners of non-measured boats may secure the rules book for twenty-five cents.


Total registered boats to date 2,684. Total chartered fleets to date 93.

More than 42 fleets are represented in the listing among them being two overseas fleets. One is in Trinidad and the other in Ireland (Ballyholme). Points for the British fleets have not come in yet but they probably will be in the next listing. There is considerable changing about in the list since last month and a great many more have been added. Two or three in final races for the season dropped below the 1,500 mark and have been taken off this listing. The high number of point score races participated in is easily held by Brothers and Obersheimer of the Buffalo Yacht Club fleet. They raced 29 times for point scores. The list printed herewith represents about one-eighth of the total number of scores received to date.

Eustace L. Adams, author and yachtsman, has been appointed chairman of the entries committee for the Midwinter Championships at Clearwater, Florida. Consequently, if you are going to take in this series, he will be glad to send you all the data. His address is simply Clearwater, Florida. The dates of the regatta are February 25, 26, and 27, 1938.

Unattached Snipes in the Chicago area are requested to get in touch with George Lawver, 1926 Sherman Avenue, Evanston, Illinois. There are dozens of such owners, many of whom would, no doubt, be interested in the Montrose Harbor fleet which has just passed its first successful season. Owners are urged to write to Mr. Lawver.

At this writing the Board of Governors of the Association are in the throes of electing a new slate of officers for 1938. Fleets are again requested to hold their annual fleet elections as early as possible so that the proper names and addresses of fleet captains may be incorporated in the 1938 rule book. Fleets having any suggested changes in the restrictions or rules of the Association should also send these in so that they may be given consideration by the Rules Committee.

One of the best handled contests for small boat skippers raced during the season in southern California proved to be the first annual Interclub team championships, using Snipe class sloops.

Three races were sailed September 26, over triangular courses off the Los Angeles Yacht Club, with five teams in action. The team from Long Beach-Alamitos Bay Yacht Club—romped into a total of 105¼ collective points and victory. Dick Russel earned 40 points, Fred Schenck 39¼, Jack Homer 26.

Los Angeles Yacht Club team earned 87½ points for second, although young Darby Metcalfe, an outstanding 1937 contributor, topped the individual scoring with 43½ points for his team. J. Salmond earned 24 points and B. Gard, 20.

Balboa Yacht Club's 67 points were earned by D. McClure, 34; R. Allen, 26, and J. Lighthipe, 7. The 55 points of Hi 'n Dri Yacht Club were earned by J. Cowie, 33; E. Munsey, 14, and I. Rohland, 8. Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club's 43 points were earned by G. Frias, 25; H. Lawhorne, 11, and R. Tompkins, 7.

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
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
