
## Origami Marine Life: Fish how to



## For this activity you will need:

- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 piece of paper
- 1 ruler
- 1 pencil or pen or marker




1. The first thing we need to do is create a square. Take your piece of paper and fold along the red dotted line, bringing the corner over to the opposite edge.










2. Using your ruler and pencil/pen/marker, mark along the green dotted line (where the triangle meets the rectangle).





3. Remove the ruler and unfold the paper. Use your scissors to cut along the pencil/pen/marker line (the pink dotted line).








4. Take the square piece of paper you just made. Turn it on its point (so it looks like a diamond). Fold the square in half along the red dotted line to create a triangle.












5. Fold the top two points of the triangle along the red dotted lines to meet the bottom point.







6. Fold the bottom points of the flaps along the dotted red lines up to meet the top point of the diamond.







7. Fold the top point of each flap along the red dotted line so that they point outwards.










8. Fold the top layer of the bottom triangle towards the top point of the diamond, creasing along the dotted red line so that the new point stops below the top point of the diamond.






9. Fold the top layer along the dotted red line to create a band.






10. Flip the fish over. Fold the bottom triangle up to meet the top triangle along the dotted red line.








11. Push gently on the two side points of the triangle. Squash your fish inwards Then fold to create a diamond.






12. Cut the top layer only along both green dotted lines. You should not cut the entire way along this upper layer triangle.






13. Fold the upper layer outwards along the red dotted line to create half a tail.








14. Flip the fish over. Repeat steps 12 and 13 on the other side.



15. Give your fish an eye and a smile. You are all done!
